- The advertisement as stipulated under Sections 110 and 108 read with Rules 20 and 22 of Companies (Management and administration) Rules, 2014 as amended on 19<sup>th</sup> March 2015, were published in Business Standard (Hindi) on 9th December 2023 and Business Standard (English) on 9th December 2023 in New Delhi edition.
- The Members holding shares on the "cut-off" date i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> December 2023 were entitled to vote on the proposed resolutions (item no. 1 and 7 as set out in the Notice of Postal Ballot dated 05<sup>th</sup> December 2023).
- 4.
